Ronan Toolis

After our time travels across Scotland over the past year, it feels good to come home to the Borders and to be concluding our 2023-24 lecture programme this month with a talk about some exciting local archaeology. Following our AGM on Thursday 2nd May, Dr Ronan Toolis, CEO of GUARD Archaeology, will be revealing the fascinating results from his recent excavations around Drumelzier and Broughton.

Instigated by the Arthur Trail Association and led by GUARD Archaeology, the Discovering Drumelzier's Hidden Heritage excavations were undertaken in 2022 by a team of volunteers from far and wide, including many people who had never

participated in an archaeological dig before. The idea of the project has been

to promote a greater understanding of Dark Age (or, for the purists among you, Early Medieval) Scotland in the Borders through public participation - 'learning by doing'!

Focussing on Tinnis Castle and hillfort, the team of volunteers, including several members of our Society and Biggar Archaeology Group, explored archaeological sites connected with the Merlin legend that has been associated with the village of Drumelzier since the medieval

period. The team were investigating if there were any archaeological roots to the story, by looking to see if the archaeological sites are actually contemporary with the late sixth century

AD when the local legend was set.

Ronan's investigations uncovered archaeology from the Bronze Age to the Medieval period and what was discovered will be revealed in his talk at St Joseph's Neighbourhood Centre, Rosetta Road, Peebles on Thursday 2nd May at 7.30pm. There will be a short AGM before the talk but don't let that put vou off! All are welcome! (PAS members, free; guest, £4 at the door).

PEEBLES TRIATHLON CLUB

Many people have heard the word 'Ironman', or perhaps in recent years seen Triathlon events as part of the Olympic or other world games. Not so many people realise that Triathlon has been a part of Peebles sporting life since the late 1980s, when a group of local athletes started training,

entering, and organising fledgling events in the UK and beyond. Fast forward to the present day, and Peebles Triathlon Club is a flourishing local organisation, affiliated to Triathlon Scotland, and always happy to welcome new members.

Currently, membership is restricted to those over 18 as we do not have a junior section. The club caters for members of all abilities, from people who have never participated in a Triathlon (but would like to) across the whole spectrum of levels and event types up to and



beyond Ironman (or full distance) events. We train at Peebles Swimming Pool on a Monday evening, where our qualified coaches are able to offer planned sessions for swimmers of all levels. In the summer months, we also have open water sessions, swimming in Gladhouse Reservoir and St Mary's Loch/Loch o' the Lowes. Run training takes place on a Monday evening, slightly earlier so that if folk wish they can access coached sessions for both running and swimming.

Additionally, through a series of Whats App groups, members also organise a wide variety of extra runs both on road and

Additionally, through a series of WhatsApp groups, members also organise a wide variety of extra runs both on road and trail. Cycling sessions take place both during the week and at weekends, with rides taking place on both road and mountain bikes.

The club also organises events for members: in June we have a Relay Triathlon event at St Mary's Loch, in August our annual 'Tweedman' event with swim, cycle, and run events of varying lengths. We also run other multisport activities throughout the year, trips to larger events, and an annual Christmas Ceilidh.

Gardening Tips from Woodside

Well, what a cold and wet Spring it has been so far. Here's hoping that May will see some improvement in the weather and we can make up for some lost time in the garden.

Although the days are getting warmer and sunnier, it is still cold at nights, so beware of planting out frost tender plants, such as courgettes, runner beans and summer bedding too early. Before planting out you should harden off tender plants by leaving them outside during the day and bringing them back under cover at night for 7 to 10 days before planting outdoors. Even then you should watch the weather forecast and have some fleece handy to throw over them at nights if necessary. Summer hanging baskets can be planted up now and grown on in the greenhouse, before hanging up outside later in the month. Use a good quality compost mixed with slow-release fertiliser and water-retaining crystals, to keep them in looking good all season long. Remember to open greenhouse vents and doors on warm days to let the air circulate and to prevent plants becoming too hot.

Now is a really good time to get your pond planted up with a good mix of submerged oxygenating plants, which will keep the water healthy and help keep it clean, along with marginal plants and deeper water plants. A well planted pond can be one of the most attractive features in the garden, as well as providing a great habitat for wildlife. It can take some time to achieve the right balance of pond plants to have clear water – so do be patient, as the rewards will be well worth the effort.

Prune spring-flowering shrubs after flowering by removing all the flowered stems – this will improve shape and performance for next year, and will stop plants becoming overgrown and straggly. Don't forget that all pruned plants will benefit from a dose of fertiliser, so give them a good feed of Growmore, Vitax Q4 or other general fertiliser to boost growth and health. Healthy plants are also more likely to resist winter cold as well as pest and fungal problems, so it's a good idea to give all of your garden plants a Spring feed to improve their overall health and resistance. Applying a good thick layer of mulch also helps plant health, as well as keeping the weeds down, maintaining moisture during dry summers, and it looks tidy too!

Plants in containers will appreciate having the top section of loose compost removed, and some fresh compost applied. They will also benefit from a dose of fertiliser, and I find that a liquid feed is easiest for all container and pot plants. Apply every 2-4 weeks in Spring and Summer to promote healthy growth, and remember to dead-head plants regularly to keep them flowering.

In the vegetable garden you can sow directly into the ground a whole range of seeds including spinach, carrot, beetroot, spring onion and lettuce. Thin out if necessary and water well after thinning or weeding. I know some of you didn't get your seed potatoes planted last month as the ground was too wet. It's not too late to get them in now – they will quickly catch up. If you feel you've left it too late to sow seeds, don't forget that you can buy a whole range of baby vegetable plants, which can be planted straight out in the garden now. I know it's a bit of a cheat, but if it saves some time and work, then why not? Remember to protect brassicas (cabbage, kale, cauliflower, calabrese, sprouts etc) from pigeons by covering with fine mesh or fleece, and lettuces may need protecting from slugs and snails.

It's a very busy gardening month, so let's hope we get the weather to be able to enjoy it.



Shakespeare at Traquair The Merchant of Venice

This year we bring you The Merchant of Venice, deemed a difficult play as it does not deal with history, comedy, or death instead there is a moral dilemma to consider.

Written when Shakespeare could not have encountered a Jewish person because they had all been expelled, so given the current backdrop that is the tragedy of the war in Gaza, I don't think we can produce the play as it was originally written. However, by removing the offensive language we can focus on a narrative that highlights the damage the strong do to the weak.

Shylock is a character who bestrides the public consciousness of this play. He's not as is commonly misconceived 'the Merchant' of the title as his Jewishness prevents him from carrying out such an occupation.

One of the interesting aspects of his character, relates to an important figure in his life who doesn't appear in the play – his wife Leah. We don't know what happened to Leah. I imagine a childbirth tragedy leaving Shylock alone with their beautiful daughter Jessica.

The relationship with his wife and daughter explains much of how Shylock behaves.

I think Shylock never has any intention to kill Antonio by taking a pound of flesh, although he does enjoy the teasing as to whether he will lend Antonio the money and I think the pound of flesh is little more than a joke. It reflects on how he views their business, money or respect. When he discovers Jessica has eloped with one of Antonio's associates and stolen much of his wealth, this betrayal bites hard, but even harder is the gossip that Jessica has sold his wife's ring for a monkey. I think at that moment the pain is too much for Shylock, in that moment he takes refuge and lashes out at those who have oppressed him.

Yet there is no justice for Shylock. Antonio entered the bond freely, without coercion, he understood what it meant if he forfeited, but in his hubris, he thought it would never happen. Shylock looks to the law to deliver justice; however, a clever lawyer finds a loophole that not only robs Shylock of his justice but in a cruel twist of fate takes all his possessions. Worse still they take his faith from him by forcing him to convert. The Christian characters congratulate themselves for their cleverness and are delighted by this 'happy' ending.

Perhaps the greatest example of human scapegoating – The Shoah – took place in an educated, Christian, Western society. When we look around us today at the treatment of many groups on the margins, have we really changed? In our production of The Merchant of Venice I hope we can recognise the complicated and messy stories that lie beneath the faces of the people we encounter every day.

PEEBLESSHIRE YOUTH TRUST



The first few months of 2024 have been busy as ever at Peeblesshire Youth Trust. We are now working with over 70 young people, helping to reach their potential.

We held our Achieve Your Potential workshops at the Scout Hall in Peebles and at Broomlee, West Linton, where our new group of Primary 6 pupils from schools across Tweeddale had the chance to make new friends, learn new skills and play games. Our activities aim to build confidence and self-esteem through challenges requiring teamwork, decision making, expressing of opinions and positive relationships. Following completion of this workshop series, our young people are offered the chance to be supported by a volunteer mentor, with whom they will meet each month to go out to try new things and explore new places.

We also invite our young people to a group activity each month. This year we have enjoyed an inflatables session at Peebles Swimming Pool and a youth club style evening at the Drill Hall, with pizzas, pool and puzzles. We are hoping for dry weather for our upcoming scavenger hunt! We are looking forward to attending a film night at the Eastgate, watching Kung Fu Panda 4 – this event on 2nd May is hosted by Peebles Youth Voice and is open to all in P6-7 and S1-6.

We held our fundraiser, Achieve-a-Ball, at Peebles Hydro on 2nd March, raising over £5500. These funds are vital to enable PYT to offer all our services free, to continue working with more and more children, and to expand our programmes to meet current needs. As such, we will soon begin pilot projects working to support primary pupils prior to P6, and to engage small groups of S2/3 pupils at Peebles High School to help build good emotional wellbeing. We are excited to pilot these new areas of work, in addition to our existing projects!

Our next fundraiser will be held at Peebles Golf Club on 14th May, in association with our principal sponsor Harrisons, Your Ford Centre. As Peebles Golf Club donate the use of the course all monies raised go directly to PYT. Our prizes are kindly sponsored by Evolution Bottling and Packaging Solutions and Holland & Sherry. We look forward to welcoming over 80 golfers on the day and promise we have ordered sunshine!

We are currently putting plans in place for our transition project for summer 2024, working with P7s from all Tweeddale primary schools to help ease the move to Peebles High School. We will be hosting this alongside our friends at Oor Space Youthy, with fun sessions open to all P7 pupils – more details will be shared soon! We will also be helping staff at Peebles HS to support the enhanced transition sessions within the school during May.

At PYT we can only do all that we do thanks to our valued volunteers, many of whom are matched as mentors with individual children. We hold quarterly Inspire sessions where our mentors have the chance to network with each other, to get ideas and inspiration for their mentoring journey, as well as receiving ongoing training from our staff. Mentoring only takes up a little amount of time, around 2 hours per month, but is hugely rewarding. We are always on the look-out for new mentors, and continually have young people that we are seeking to match with a mentor. No prior experience is needed as full training is given - just bags of enthusiasm, a little patience, and the ability to have fun!
